Baler belts are engineered to perform a unique and important job. Baler belting can be destroyed and the warranty voided if incorrectly stored. That's why it's important to store your belting away from moisture, chemicals, and other damaging elements.

Here are some DOs and DON'Ts for proper baler belt storage:

DON'T

- Store belting outside or exposed to elements
- Allow belting edges to rest on the bare ground, concrete, or any other source of moisture
- Store belting in or around chemicals and petroleum-based products
- Store long term in high heat or high moisture



DO

- Store belting so that the edges are not contacting any source of moisture
- Store belting edge down *only* when on a dry pallet, in a dry environment
- Store belting indoors
- Store belting in a dry environment at all times
